Results

- Initial response resulted was \$1,568
- 11 chapters contributed
- Due to encouraging result deadline extended
- Wording changed on form
 - Give donation in honor of someone else
- E-mail reminders sent
- Total raised \$2500 from 13 chapters
 - 40% response rate!
