TEAM LEADERSHIP PROJECT

Background

 Efforts to retain and support new nurse faculty are important to addressing faculty shortages and preparing nurse faculty who are well-positioned to assume leadership roles in academia.

Purpose

 The purpose of this project was to identify faculty mentoring needs and implement mentoring activities based on the need that promoted collaboration and supported nursing faculty.

Outcomes

- Seven monthly mentoring mingles were completed based on the needs assessment.
- Survey results indicated high satisfaction with mentoring mingles.
- Faculty attendees reported mentoring mingles created an environment for collaboration and engagement among faculty.
- Strong support from East Carolina University College of Nursing for sustainability of mentoring program.

Implications for Nursing Education

 Mentoring new faculty has the ability to influence perceived competence, promote faculty retention, and influence leadership abilities in nursing academia.
