Benefits of Posting in the Virginia Henderson Global Nursing e-Repository

Benefits to individuals:

- **Increased visibility** of the work via an **open-access, worldwide, online resource backed by Sigma** (Research has shown that work published in open-access repositories can gain up to 300% more citations than research published in journals that limit access through paid subscriptions. That results in increased exposure to your work. Increasingly, more research funding bodies are insisting that work carried out under their grants must also be deposited within an institutional or subject specific repository.)
- Ability to **quantify impact** of posted works via built-in statistics features. Track item views and file downloads, plus follow social media mentions via [Altmetric](#).
- **Free** and convenient way to preserve clinical and/or scholarly output.
- **Copyright retention by the author.**
- **Credibility of peer-review process** prior to an item's acceptance and posting (Independent Submissions community only).

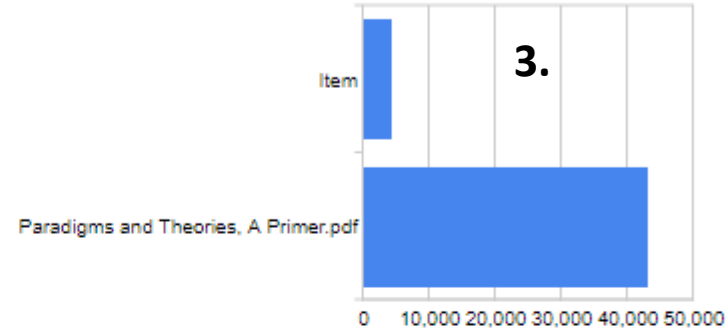

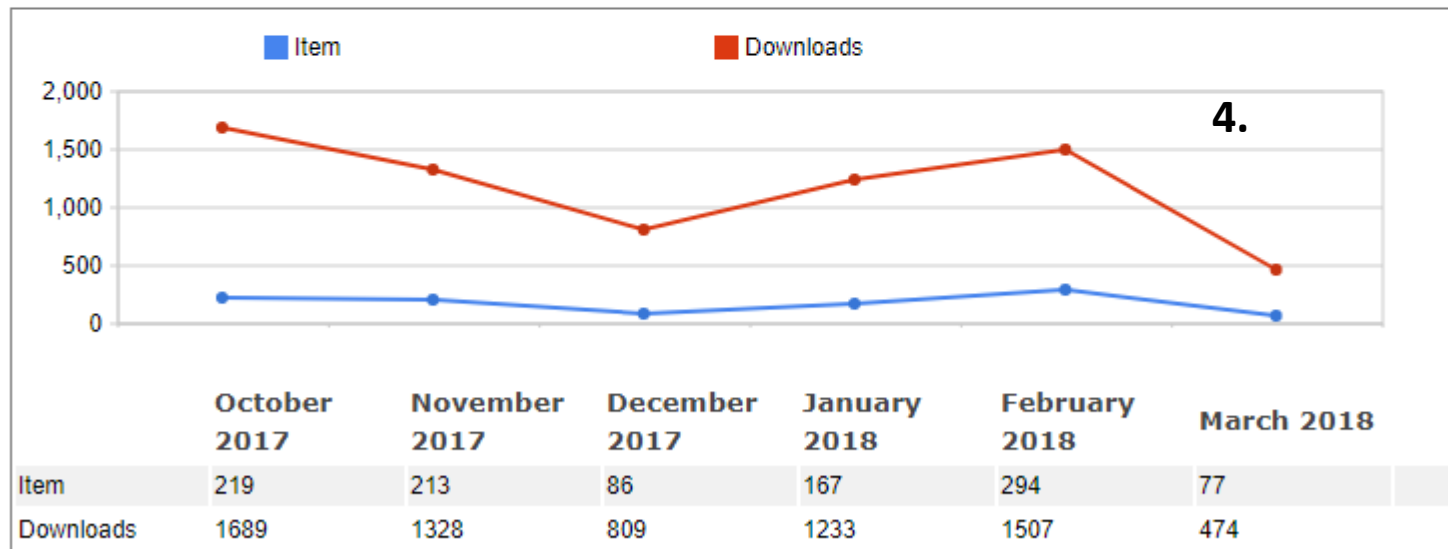

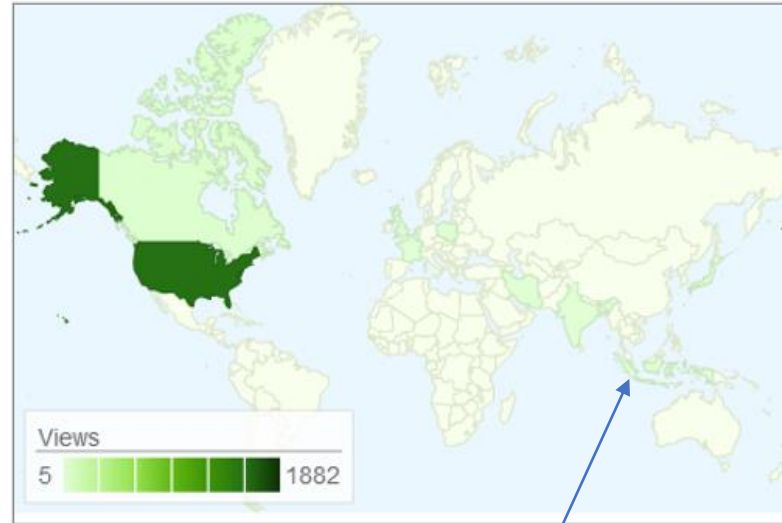

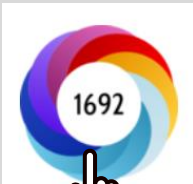

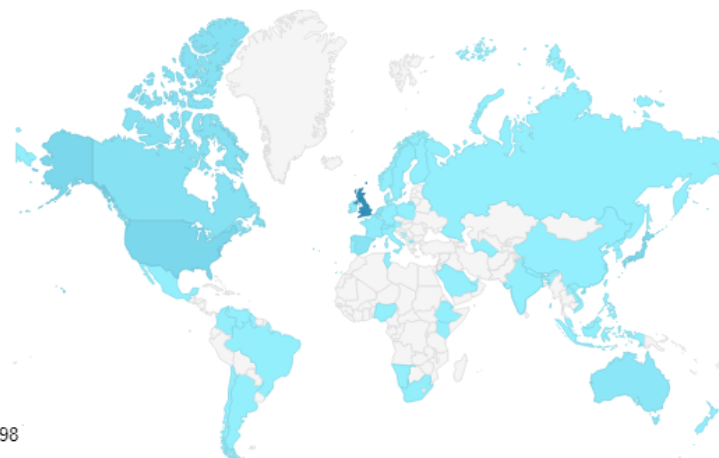

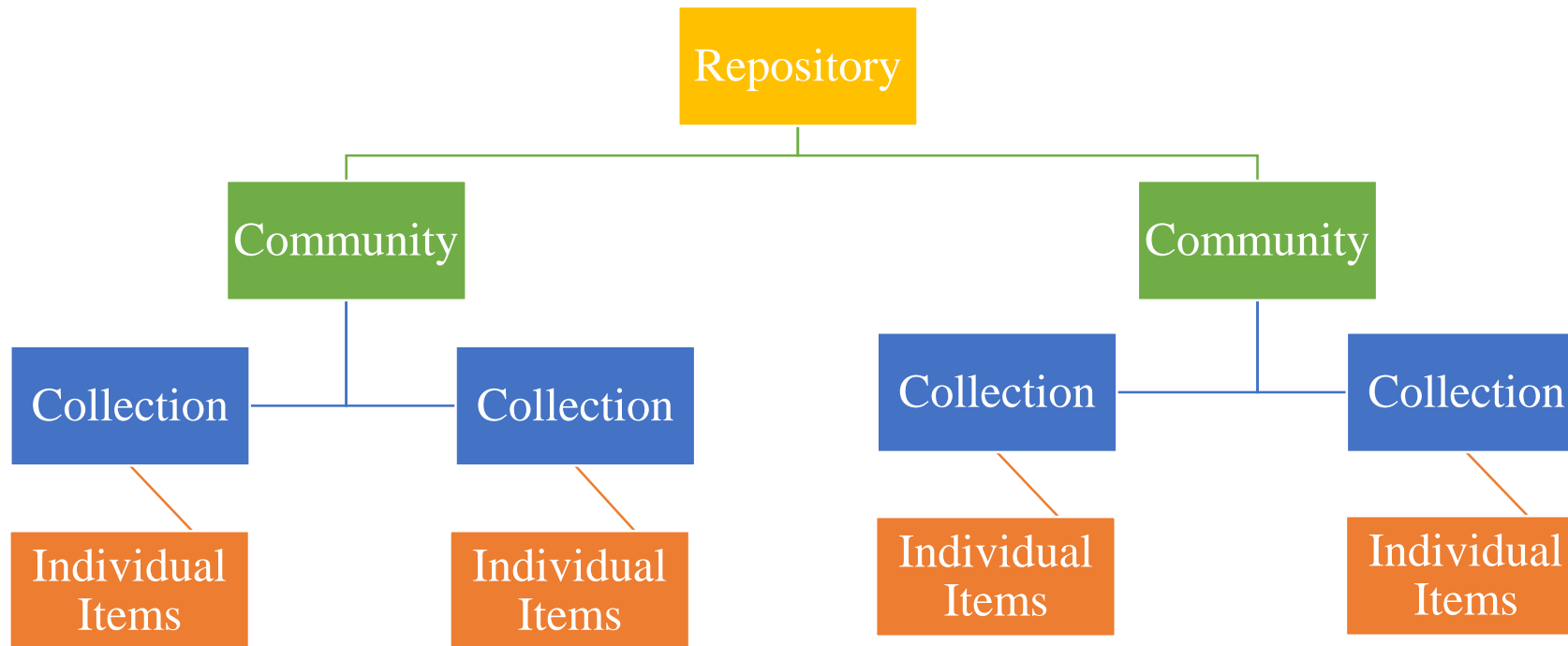

- Individual Nurses/Nursing Students* – Distribute an array of unpublished works in the open peer-reviewed collections. Share your thesis, dissertation, or capstone (schools of nursing included).
- Hospitals/Healthcare Systems – Showcase evidence-based practice materials, best practices, and research from nursing staff (created as employees).
- Continuing Nursing Education – Work with the Sigma continuing nursing education and repository managers to develop course materials housed in the repository.
- National/International Nursing Organizations – Share event materials and corporate-authored resource papers.
- Sigma Events – Poster and slides are transferred to the repository when authorized by the presenter.

*Nurses must hold a baccalaureate or above from an accredited program.
