



# 1. Login and Registration

Registration and login are not required to search and view materials posted in the repository.


Registration (one-time step) and login are necessary for submission or setting up favorite collection notifications!





## Benefits of Posting in the Virginia Henderson Global Nursing e-Repository Benefits to individuals:

- Increased visibility of the work via an open-access, worldwide, online resource backed by Sigma (Research has shown that work published in open-access repositories can gain up to 300% more citations than research published in journals that limit access through paid subscriptions. That results in increased exposure to your work. Increasingly, more research funding bodies are insisting that work carried out under their grants must also be deposited within an institutional or subject specific repository.)
- Ability to quantify impact of posted works via built-in statistics features. Track item views and file downloads, plus follow social media mentions via <u>Altmetric</u>.
- Free and convenient way to preserve clinical and/or scholarly output.
- Copyright retention by the author.
- Credibility of peer-review process prior to an item's acceptance and posting (Independent Submissions community only).
- Increased impact on the nursing research community due to enhanced visibility/ease of access.



## Total Visits (All Time)




### File Downloads (All Time)







- Brand a collection in the repository with its logo and explanatory text.
- Place a link to its website on its collection homepage.
- Retain copyright to the materials in its collection.
- Place additional requirements on submissions beyond those set by the repository.
- Choose a collection workflow option from established options, if applicable.

## Important Information

- The Henderson Repository is not a host for other repositories.
- All communities and collections within the repository are under the jurisdiction of Sigma.
- Creation of a collection bearing the name/logo of a participating group does not give the group ownership or partnership rights in the repository.
